- Martha Heeszal of Public Health indicated that Senior Services is going strong. They are back at Veteran's Hall after a brief time at the Tulsa Scott building at the fairgrounds. They serve 26,000 meals at the site and another 16,000 meals to home bound seniors.
- Patty O'Neill-Porges of Child Support Services announced August is Child Support Awareness Month as recognized by the State of California and by proclamation from the Board of Supervisors. There had a successful outreach booth at the fair, although she was disappointed by the lower fair attendance.
- Karen Hayden of Social Services she is preparing for a new web based system for their department. The new system will be up in 2010, which requires much preparation and data clean-up.
- Randy Schwartz of Alcohol and Drug was hopefully that his department would remain intact. He indicated they are still providing services at this time.
