RE: **Important Voter Information for the November 4, 2008 General Election -**

1. The Office of the Plumas County Clerk-Recorder, Elections Division reminds you that OCTOBER 20, 2008 is the DEADLINE to REGISTER TO VOTE in the upcoming election.
2. "Vote By Mail" ballots are currently available at the Elections Division Office at the courthouse. You may pick up your ballot and save time by BRINGING YOUR APPLICATION FORM found on the back of your Sample Ballot Voter Information Guide.
3. The LAST day a Vote By Mail ballot can be returned to the Elections Office or to a Plumas County Polling Center is TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2008, ELECTION DAY! Ballots arriving in the mail after that day will not be counted, postmarks ARE NOT considered!
4. Mail your VOTE BY MAIL ballot early. By law, your ballot cannot be counted if it does not reach our office by ELECTION DAY. If you have requested a ballot and have not received it within 1 week, call the Elections Office.
5. If you have moved and not re-registered, you may not be eligible to vote. Only voters registered to vote in Plumas County are eligible to vote here. You must re-register each time you move within the county or if you are new to the county.
6. Remember, per California State Election Law, Electioneering is not permitted within 100 feet of any polling place. Voters may not wear items into polling places in support of candidates or measures. This includes the Courthouse which is also a polling place.
